



## ***Mason County General Election***

***Nov. 5, 2024***

- **Mail – In Absentee Voting**

Applications may be submitted Sept. 21 - Oct. 22 through the online portal at **govote.ky.gov**. The deadline to apply for a mail-in absentee ballot is Oct. 22, 2024, at 11:59 p.m.

- **EXCUSED In-person Absentee Voting**

Excused in-person absentee voting is for those voters who meet statutory criteria to vote in person prior to Election Day. In-person excused absentee voting will be held at the **Mason County Clerk's Office**, located at 27 W. 3rd Street, Maysville, on Oct. 23, 24, 25, 28, 29 and 30 from 8:30 a.m. until 4:30 p.m.

- **No-Excuse Early Voting**

Early voting will be held at two locations. Those locations are:

**Mason County Public Library**, located at 218 East 3rd Street, Maysville, and the **Mason County Extension Service**, located at 800 US 68, Maysville.

Early voting will be conducted on Oct. 31, Nov. 1 and 2, from 8:30 a.m. until 4:30 p.m. Early voting is for any voter who wants to cast his or her ballot prior to Election Day.

- **Election Day**

Election Day is Tuesday, Nov. 5. The hours for voting are 6 a.m. until 6 p.m. Mason County will offer five vote centers for the General Election. Any voter may go to any vote center to cast his or her ballot. Vote center locations are:
