



## ***Mason County Primary Election***

***May 21, 2024***

- **Mail – In Absentee Voting**

Applications may be submitted April 6 – May 7 through the online portal at **govote.ky.gov**. The deadline to apply for a mail-in absentee ballot is May 7, 2024, at 11:59 p.m.

- **EXCUSED In-person Absentee Voting**

Excused in-person absentee voting is for those voters who meet statutory criteria to vote in person prior to Election Day. In-person excused absentee voting will be held at the **Mason County Clerk's Office**, located at 27 W. 3rd Street, Maysville, on May 8, 9, 10, 13, 14 and 15 from 8:30 a.m. until 4:30 p.m.

- **No-Excuse Early Voting**

Early voting will be held at the **Mason County Public Library**, located at 218 East 3rd Street, Maysville, on May 16, 17 and 18, from 8:30 a.m. until 4:30 p.m. Early voting is for any voter who wants to cast his or her ballot prior to Election Day.

- **Election Day**

Election Day is Tuesday, May 21. The hours for voting are 6 a.m. until 6 p.m. Mason County will offer five vote centers for the Primary Election. Any voter may go to any vote center to cast his or her ballot. Vote center locations are:
